

Wes Allen
Secretary of State

Wes Allen was sworn in as Alabama's 54th Secretary of State on January 16, 2023. A lifelong Republican, he served as Pike County's Probate Judge for nearly a decade before being elected to serve District 89 in the Alabama House of Representatives. As Alabama's Chief Elections Official, Wes works closely with local officials across the state to ensure that Alabama's elections remain the most secure in the nation.

Just minutes after taking the Oath of Office, he kept his first campaign promise by signing the letter officially withdrawing Alabama from the ERIC system. Wes and his team at the Secretary of State's Office developed and implemented an Alabama-based solution to ERIC – the Alabama Voter Integrity Database, better known as AVID.

Since taking Office, he has championed legislative action that both strengthened the security of Alabama elections and reduced government red tape for business owners and candidates alike. Major wins of his legislative agendas include banning internet connectivity for election tabulators, requiring the use of paper ballots in all Alabama elections, outlawing absentee ballot harvesting and ranked choice voting, and expanding the Alabama crimes of moral turpitude law. Wes also supported legislation that removed burdensome red tape and fees for Alabama business owners and unnecessary reporting requirements for municipal candidates.

He has also provided local election officials with tools to recruit qualified poll workers with his Lawyers for Liberty and Heroes at the Polls initiatives.

He earned his undergraduate degree from the University of Alabama where he played football for the Crimson Tide. He received his Master's degree from Troy University. He and his wife, Cae, have two children. Davis is a graduate of Troy University. Dee is a student at the University of Alabama. They are members of First Baptist Church of Troy, where Wes is an ordained Deacon and Sunday School leader.

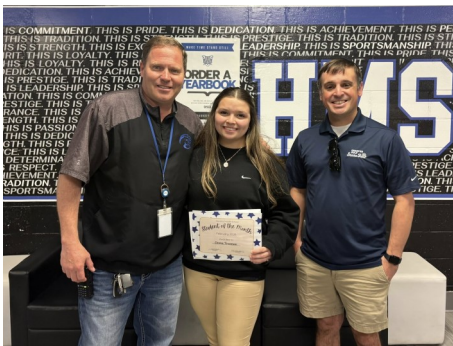

THE REAL ESTATE CORNER:



Audubon Companies LLC, a subsidiary of Houston-based Nobel Energy, has completed its acquisition of Alliance Engineering, a West Mobile engineering and construction management firm with offices across the Southeast. The deal gives Audubon a stronger position beyond its traditional energy-focused business by adding Alliance's client relationships and capabilities in manufacturing, food and beverage, pulp and paper, specialty chemicals and other industrial sectors. Alliance provides mechanical, electrical, structural, piping and process engineering, along with project and construction management services. Audubon said the acquisition strengthens its integrated project delivery platform and supports growth across a broader mix of industrial markets. Alliance's leadership and key staff are expected to remain in place, providing continuity for clients and ongoing projects throughout the region.

Mobile's updated master plan for the Peninsula area is also moving forward, reviving a waterfront redevelopment effort that had slowed during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Peninsula, south of Interstate 10 along Dauphin Island Parkway, is bordered by Mobile Bay and Dog River. At a recent public meeting, residents reviewed early concepts and offered feedback on potential improvements. While no construction timeline has been announced, the city's immediate goal is to complete a shovel-ready plan that can support future funding and project scheduling. The effort includes McNally Park, Perch Creek Preserve, the former Ziebach water treatment plant property and nearby Helen Wood Park. Together, the three main sites total about 190 acres of waterfront property. Proposed improvements include nature trails, boardwalks, fishing piers, shoreline coves and stronger connections for walking, biking and paddling between the sites.

In West Mobile, a new 1,100-square-foot Merle Norman Cosmetics Studio & Boutique has opened at 720 Schillinger Road South, Suite 12. The business is owned by Melissa Guesnard and offers personalized skincare and makeup consultations, along with a try-before-you-buy retail experience. In addition to cosmetics, the boutique carries accessories including handbags, gloves, jewelry, scarves and hats. Guesnard said in a social media post that the studio is designed to make beauty feel empowering for customers.

In a separate transaction, a local family investment group has sold 130 acres on Bellingrath Road near the Alabama State Port Authority for \$1.35 million. The family had owned the property for more than 50 years. The buyer, described as an out-of-state industrial developer with maritime interests, reflects continued demand for industrial land tied to port, logistics and shipping activity in the Mobile market. The seller was represented by John Peebles and William Peebles of City Management Co., while Doug Adams of Berkshire Hathaway HomeServices Cooper & Co. represented the buyer in the deal.
