THE REAL ESTATE CORNER:



MYER Industries LLC plans to invest \$2.3 million to establish a new manufacturing headquarters and production facility situated in Grand Bay, a project expected to create 24 new jobs over the next four years. The company, which currently operates a facility on Blackburn Drive in Mobile, has acquired an existing industrial property at 12780 Saeger Road. MYER Industries will renovate and upgrade the facility to consolidate its American Society of

Mechanical Engineers (ASME)-certified fabrication operations into a dedicated production center. A wholly owned subsidiary of MYER Cos., the company specializes in manufacturing custom pressure vessels, heat exchangers, process equipment and other heavy industrial products for customers in the industrial, chemical, marine and process sectors across the Gulf Coast and beyond. Construction is expected to begin in July, with the new facility scheduled to become operational in August.

The City of Mobile has announced an investment of \$575,000 allocated towards upgrades at the football stadium found at Trimmier Park in West Mobile, part of an effort to improve recreational facilities across the city. The project includes new field lighting, electrical upgrades to support the stadium's irrigation system and a new scoreboard. Construction is expected to enhance the experience of athletes, coaches and spectators while improving the park's overall infrastructure. Mobile Mayor Spiro Cheriogotis said the work reflects the city's ongoing commitment to maintaining quality public recreational spaces. "I'm excited to see Bill Smith Electric start on this work and for players to have an updated stadium soon," he said.

Petsense by Tractor Supply has opened a new 1,100-square-foot store located in Theodore, expanding access to pet supplies and grooming services in southern Mobile County. The new location is at 7371 Theodore Dawes Road, Suite 670. Petsense, a wholly owned subsidiary of Tractor Supply, specializes in pet products, including food, supplies for dogs, cats and small animals, exotic pet care items, and a full-service grooming salon. The new location expands the retailer's footprint in the Mobile area.

Last month it was announced that Lavretta Park is expected to receive a \$1.1 million playground renovation, marking the first major upgrade to the facility since 2001. The project will feature separate play areas designed for children ages 2 to 5 and 5 to 12. Planned amenities include swings, a climbing wall, a zip track, a mound-and-tunnel play area, slides, shade canopies, benches and other park improvements. Construction is expected to begin after the start of the upcoming school year. The investment is part of the city's ongoing efforts to modernize public parks and expand recreational opportunities for families.
