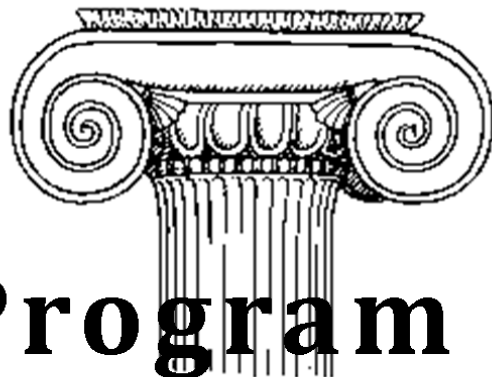

**Mission:**

The Southwest Mobile County Chamber is committed to encouraging and developing young leaders who will make a positive impact in their community through meaningful leadership experiences.

**About:**

T.A.L.L. (Tillman's Corner Area Learning Leadership) is an eight-month leadership development program of the Southwest Mobile County Chamber of Commerce, running from September through April and concluding with a graduation ceremony.

The program provides students with hands-on learning through leadership training, interaction with community leaders, educational field trips, and volunteer service. Participants gain insight into local economic, political, and social issues while building leadership, communication, and decision-making skills.

Students are selected through a competitive application process based on academics, school involvement, and community engagement. Completion of the T.A.L.L. Program is required for scholarship eligibility.

**Eligibility & Requirements:**

Applicants must be high school seniors during the 2026–2027 academic year, attend school in Mobile County, and maintain a minimum 3.0 weighted GPA. Selection is based on leadership potential, academic achievement, and community involvement.

Finalists will be invited to an in-person interview on Thursday, June 18, 2026. Selections will be made in June, and all applicants will be notified by July.

A complete application packet, including the application, transcript, three references, and photo, must be submitted together by **May 22, 2026**. Partial packets and emailed submissions will not be accepted.

**Expectations:**

Participants must attend all monthly sessions, complete required service activities, and represent the Chamber in a professional manner. Attendance is required for program completion and scholarship consideration. A \$25 registration fee is required to cover program supplies.

The Southwest Mobile County Chamber will not accept partial packets, emailed materials, or items submitted separately. **No part of the application, including transcripts, references, or photographs, will be accepted by email.**
